"TENURE; RETIREMENT: The term of office of justices and judges of the Supreme Court, Intermediate Appellate Court and Circuit Court shall be ten years. Judges of the District Courts shall hold office for the periods provided by law. At least six months prior to the expiration of a justice's or judge's term of office, every justice and judge shall petition the Judicial Selection Commission to be retained in office or shall inform the Commission of an intention to retire. If the Judicial Selection Commission determines that a justice or judge should be retained in office, the Commission shall renew the term of office of the justice or judge for the period provided by this section or by law. Justices and judges shall be retired upon attaining the age of seventy years."

The Constitution also provides that no justice or judge shall, during the term of office, engage in the practice of law, or run for or hold any other office or position of profit under the United States, the State or its political subdivisions.
