It is not practicable or advantageous for the State of Hawaii Judiciary to replace Veracity Consulting, Inc. the infrastructure vendor during the JIMS DC-Crim release 2 In-Court Processing project and during preparation of the next Request for Proposals. Any new vendor would experience a high-learning curve to understand JIMS, resulting in a disruption of the project and its timeline. A panel consisting of various levels of Judiciary employees are currently assembled to prepare the RFP to solicit and select the best vendor for this contract eff. July 1, 2014. R#3034.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:

Veracity Consulting, Inc. was contracted via Request for Proposal (RFP) J09040 in 2008. The 7-month extension to this contract will expire on January 31, 2014 and a request for an additional extension to end no later than June 30, 2014 is being requested. The new RFP will be issued to solicit and award the next infrastructure vendor. The next infrastructure vendor is expected to be contracted by July 1, 2014.
