NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION

*Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:*

<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction: Your approval is respectfully requested for an exemption from Chapter 103D, HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, to purchase and expand the video surveillance system from Security Resources for the Second Circuit at Hoapili Hale. Security Resources will be installing twenty-one (21) additional security cameras to expand our current system which was originally installed in September 2013.</p>

<p>6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: On September 1, 2013, we originally installed one (1) American Dynamic Video Edge NVR, eight (8) American Dynamics Illustra 610 MP Cameras, five (5) Arecont 8 MP 180deg Cameras, three (3) DLink 10 Port PoE GB Switches, two (2) Dell OptiPlex Series PCs and CAT6 Cables at Hoapili Hale. Installation included all equipment, software, hardware, licensing and programming. The installation of the new video surveillance system was procured through HEPS solicitation. The system's original warranty from Security Resources will expire on September 1, 2015. The two year warranty will be considered void and null should any company other than Security Resources, manipulate, change or provide service for the products covered under this warranty, to include but not limited to the NVR, PCs, Cameras, Switches and Cabling. With additional cameras and appropriate equipment, along with the existing thirteen (13) camera surveillance system, the system can be linked together, which will allow the single system to be managed by one main control station without voiding the current warranty. Therefore, it would not be practical or advantageous to solicit other price quotes.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Security Resources as the original installer has the knowledge and technical expertise necessary to maintain the system and has consistently performed well during the service. Therefore, we respectfully request your approval for the exemption from Chapter 103D, HRS and Chapter 3-120 HAR, for the single bid proposal from Security Resources.</p>
