
*Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:*

<p><b>1. Describe the goods, services or construction:</b> Provide mediation services to the Department of Human Services(DHS)-Child Welfare Services(CWS) cases referred to Family Court. The purpose of the mediation is to attempt to settle cases that are pending trial or narrow the contested issues. In addition, the contractor shall attend and participate in quarterly stakeholder meetings.</p>

<p><b>4. Term of Contract From: To:</b> October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014</p>	<p><b>5. Prior Judiciary Procurement Exemption No. (if applicable):</b></p>
<p><b>6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:</b> Judiciary has an existing contract with Mr. Raymond Zeason which he has providing mediation services in child welfare case. Mr. Zeason has been doing mediation for the past three years through the William S. Richardson School of Law. The purpose of the mediation is to attempt to settle cases that are pending trial or narrow the contested issues. In light of this, it would not be feasible to conduct another solicitation. Selecting another contractor will create an impracticable situation, as the contractor is not aware of the Child Welfare System and expectations; therefore, we are requesting an exemption from the provision of 103D.</p>	
<p><b>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:</b> Mr. Zeason has been doing mediation for the past three years through the William S. Richardson School and Law and the past year with the Judiciary. He is considered an expert and has experience in providing mediation to the Department of Human Services- Child Welfare Services. In addition, continuing with Mr. Zeason minimizes training of a new contractor.</p>


