Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:</p> <p>In September of 2015, Hoapili Hale upgraded its Sonitrol Card Key System to the Premysis Access Control System via Security Resources Pacific (SRP), Inc. Hoapili Hale needs to add three (3) additional access control hardware to doors within our Court building. This system is currently under a maintenance contract, and has one (1) system integrator statewide. Therefore, we are requesting an exemption from HRS Chapter 103D for these additions to the existing system.</p>

Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:</p> <p>Pursuant to HAR Chapter 3-122-81, the exemption request will allow the existing vendor, Security Resources Pacific Inc., to install the three (3) additional access control hardware to doors in Hoapili Hale Court building as the Premysis Access Control system is currently under a maintenance contract and has one (1) system integrator statewide.</p>
