Pursuant to HRS § 103D -102 (b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, The Judiciary requests a procurement exemption for the following:

<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction:</p> <p>A new duress alarm system called KAS (Keyboard Alert Service) will replace the existing system in Ali'iolani Hale and the Kapuaiwa Building. KAS will utilize our existing desktop keyboards to provide employees with a means to quickly and discretely notify deputy sheriffs at the State Capitol of an emergency situation. A pre-designed keystroke is programmed to any keyboard within our two buildings, up to 100 users, or more if so desired. KAS will also integrate with our existing mass text messaging provider, TxtWire, to provide instant text messages of a duress condition to any predetermined, essential Judiciary employee.</p>

Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:</p> <p>The KAS software is specifically designed to integrate with our existing physical security information management software (Lighthouse), which currently resides on our server at district court. Both KAS and Lighthouse are manufactured by Network Harbor. Security Resources (SR) is the access and control provider who installed Lighthouse. The Judiciary has worked with SR since 2006, and they have consistently provided exception service and repair work. Because of their intimate knowledge and technical expertise, SR currently holds the annual maintenance contract for Lighthouse. In addition, SR is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified and trained to integrate KAS into Lighthouse.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:</p> <p>Because Security Resources (SR) is the only authorized Lighthouse integrator in Hawaii, SR will be selected on that basis. Please see attached letter from Network Harbor, dated May 5, 2016.</p>
