It is not practicable or not advantageous to procure by competitive means because Straub offers more accessible locations throughout different regions of Oahu. Straub has four (4) locations on Oahu located in Pearl City, Kailua, Kapolei and Waikiki. Straub provides multiple locations throughout Oahu and provides clinic hours on weekends, allowing services seven (7) days a week, to include a clinic in close proximity to the Detention Facility in Kapolei, which would greatly benefit the Judiciary due to the high utilization rate.				
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7. Explain in de	tail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting th	ne vendor/contractor/service provider:		
Straub was chosen based on a couple factors which benefit the Judiciary: 1) Straub facilities (location of clinics and offices) are located in different regions of Oahu which provides more accessibility to our employees, and 2) Straub offers extended hours of operations which are necessary to the purpose and nature of the current program. As such, Straub was the more suitable vendor to insure the Judiciary meets the program requirements.
