Describe the goods, services or construction:</b> K6057 To provide Guardian Ad Litem and/or legal Services on behalf of children and parents who are parties in Hawaii Revised Statutes, Chapter 587 proceedings; youngsters in Hawaii Revised Statutes, Chapter 571 proceedings; and other miscellaneous hearings which are heard in the Family Courts.

Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:</b> Mr. Schlueter has been a licensed and practicing attorney in the State of Hawaii since 2006. Mr. Schluleter has considerable experience representing clients in civil litigation, family law and criminal defense matters with the Third Circuit. Efforts to recruit attorneys through the Request for Proposal process under J16003 in 2015, did not produce enough attorneys to absorb the amount of referrals from the Family Court of the Third Circuit.  Due to the shortage of GAL/LC providers in West Hawaii, it is critical for the Judiciary to contract with Mr. Schlueter	
<b>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:</b> Mr. Schlueter has expressed an interest in becoming a Guardian Ad Litem for the Third Circuit. Due to lack of adequate response to the 2015 RFP J16003 and possible retirements of other contracted attorneys, it was decided by administration and the current presiding Family Court judges, that the need for an experienced contracted GAL was immediate.
